Because this is a course approved under the Higher Education Support Act 2003 (HESA), eligible students' tuition fees for this qualification may be deferred under the VET Student Loans student loan scheme.

It is a requirement that only those who meet the requirements below can access VET Student Loans loan for this course. Those requirements are that a person must:

- be eligible for VET Student Loans
- meet CASA medical requirements

The tuition fees outlined above do not include the following incidental fees, which also must be met by the student:

- CASA Testing fees – refer to CASA for current costs, plus the cost of the aircraft at the current SOLO rate when required
- ASIC Card – refer to CASA for current costs
- Medical examination fee – refer to a CASA approved doctor.
- Uniform – refer to TVSA's Fee Schedule and uniform requirements.
- Textbooks and resources – TVSA provide these for \$1,000 in addition to these fees. It is the students responsibility to ensure all documents remain up to date once TVSA has provided the first set. This includes charts, publications and text books.
- Remedial flight training - Including additional training required to meet the standard.
- Height & weight fees: In the event that a student exceeds the height and weight restrictions of an aircraft required for training, they will be charged additional fees (as per current fees and charges) to fly in an aircraft suitable for their height & weight.
