**Course Deposit**

- Medical examination fees – price will depend on CASA approved medical practitioner used

- Remedial training – includes additional flight and theory training required to meet the standard
- Height & weight fees: In the event that a student exceeds the height and weight restrictions of an aircraft required for training, they will be charged additional fees (as per current fees and charges) to fly in an aircraft suitable for their height & weight.
