**Course Deposit**

- A course deposit of \$1,000 is due and payable at the time of enrolment. This will be refunded upon course completion.

**The tuition fees outlined above do not include the following incidental fees, which also must be met by the student:**

- Medical examination fees – price will depend on CASA approved medical practitioner used
- Uniform – refer to the Uniform Price List
- Textbooks and resources – refer to the 'Required Materials' list for your course
- **Remedial training – this includes additional flight and theory training required to meet the standard. Only the first attempt at each flight lesson is covered by your tuition fees. Repeat flights will be invoiced as per the current rates at the time of the flight.**
- Height & weight fees: In the event that a student exceeds the height and weight restrictions of an aircraft required for training, they will be charged additional fees (as per current fees and charges) to fly in an aircraft suitable for their height & weight.
